PERSONAL RESPONSIBILITY

The cooperation and involvement of students, faculty, and staff in a campus safety program is essential. Students, faculty, and staff can and should assume responsibility for their own personal safety and the security of their personal belongings by taking simple, commonsense precautions:

Room doors should be locked at night and when the room is unoccupied.

Valuable items, such as computers, stereos, and cameras, should be marked with engraving instruments

Bicycles should be registered and secured with a sturdy lock.

Cars should be locked at all times, and valuables that must be kept in the car should be locked in the trunk.
