- 5. Are there any risks associated with accepting the donation?
- 6. Will the donation require a special facility in which to house it?
- 7. Are there any special conditions the donor may impose?
- 8. If the property cannot to be used in university programs, will the donor allow it to be sold?
- 9. Do the benefits of accepting the donation outweigh other costs and considerations?

The Donor

Gifts of materials or long-lived assets that are directly related to the mission of the institution should be reported at the face (fair market) value. For all gifts inkind, especially items such as equipment and software, report the educational discount value (if an educational discount is offered) – that is, the value the institution would have paid had it purchased the item outright from the vendor. Regardless of what the estimated value a vendor may place on a gift in-kind, the
